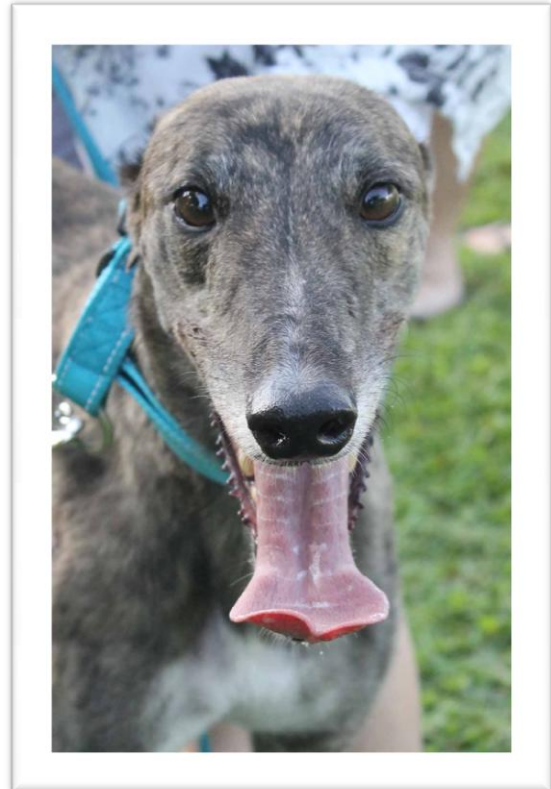


Cruise's story by Donna Giles
